The Belgian d'Uccle and the Booted Bantam are two distinct breeds. The older of the two breeds, the Booted Bantam, dates back to the 17th Century where it was imported to Holland from China. The Booted Bantam was used with the Belgian d'Anvers in the early 1900's to create the Belgian d'Uccle. Although both breeds are True Bantams and both have heavily feathered feet, the d'Uccle sports a feathery beard and muffs, has very little or no wattles and the body type is different than that of the Booted Bantam.
